MILLERSVILLE BOROUGH TRASH/RECYCLING COLLECTION UPDATE April 28, 2020

Eagle Disposal will be enforcing the following collection mandates, in an effort to protect their frontline team members, and as a result of having a limited workforce during this COVID-19 pandemic:

- All trash must be bagged and tied. If you wish, you can then put the bag(s) in your trash can. Loose items will be not be collected.
- All recyclable materials must be placed inside your recycling container, <u>including your flattened</u> <u>and bundled corrugated cardboard</u>. Recyclable items left outside of your recycling container will not be collected.
- The bag/can limit will be enforced. If you are over your limit, your trash will not be collected.
- <u>Limited</u> collection of yard waste and over-sized items will begin on <u>Monday, May 4, 2020.</u>
 - During the month of May, you can put up to <u>ten bags</u> of yard waste out for collection each week. Yard waste must be in the brown bio-degradable bags with a green extra service tag attached to each bag.
 - During the month of May, you may put **ONE** oversized item out each week, for collection. The item must have a red extra service tag attached.
 - If you need to purchase tags, you can send a check to Millersville Borough or put the money in the overnight drop box (to the left of the front doors) and we will mail the tags to you.
